1. <u>Rules:</u> United States Bowling Congress (USBC) rules and regulations will govern this tournament unless otherwise stated.

2. <u>Eligibility:</u> Participation is limited to members of the Central Alabama USBC Association who are age 50 or older on or before 1 August 2024 and certified for the 2024-2025 season. Bowlers may be required to present proof of certification at time of check-in. The Tournament Director reserves the right to deny participation to any individual that fails to provide adequate proof of current certification.

03. <u>Tournament Dates</u>: The tournament will be held on January 11 & 12, 2025 at Bowlero Montgomery. Squad times are 9:00 AM & 12:30 PM both days.

4. <u>Tournament Composition</u>: This tournament will consist of a Doubles Event (2 members), a Singles Event (Individual), and All-Events. A bowler can bowl in the Doubles without having to bowl in the Singles and bowl in the Singles without having to bowl in the Doubles. **A bowler may also bowl doubles one day and singles the next day**. A bowler's first score will count in the All-Events. A bowler must bowl doubles and singles to qualify for All-Events.

5. <u>Entry Fee:</u> Will be \$40.00 per bowler per event for doubles and singles. The fee for the optional All-Events will be \$5.00. Entry fee distribution – Lineage: \$15.00, Prize Fund: \$20.00, Expenses \$5.00. Prize fund fees for each event will be returned 100% with a 1:6 Ratio. All Events Prize Fund \$4.00 Expenses \$1.00. Prize Fund will be returned 100% with a 1:6 Ratio.

6. <u>Tournament Average</u>: Bowlers will use their highest 2023-2024 certified average of 21 games or more from the fall or winter league, whether bowled as a regular member or substitute. If your current average is 10 pins higher than your yearbook average, you must use your <u>current average</u> for this tournament. Rule 319e (Average Adjustment for Tournament Entry) is in effect.

- a. A bowler without a 2023-2024 certified average of 21 games or more may use their highest <u>current</u> certified league average of 21 games or more as of January 11, 2025. Average verification with League Secretary Signature required.
- b. A bowler without a 2023-2024 certified yearbook average or a current league average of 21 games or more as of the average cutoff date in paragraph 6(a) will bowl scratch.

7. <u>Average Verification</u>: Each team member is responsible for providing the team captain with the correct tournament average. The team captain in-turn is responsible for reporting all averages for the individual members of their team. All team members are required to verify and initial submitted averages prior to the completion of the first game of the first series bowled. Corrections must be identified prior to end of first game of the first series bowled. If the submitted average is lower than required and results in a lower classification or more handicap, the bowler's score will be disqualified. If the submitted average is higher than required, tournament standings will be based on the submitted average.

8. <u>Average Re-Rating</u>: The Tournament Director reserves the right to re-rate a participant's tournament entering average under USBC rule 319e (Average Adjustment for Tournament Entry). However, a bowler who has qualified for a prize of \$600.00 or more in any event of any tournament within the previous 12-month period must report actual scores, position and amount won to the tournament manager at time of entry. Re-rating must be accomplished and presented to participant prior to the participant bowling. Should the participant not accept the re-rated average, entry fee shall be refunded. Failure to comply with these provisions will constitute in a forfeiture of entry fee and prize money.

Note: Average re-rating only applies to Tournament Scores and Brackets

9. Tournament Handicap: Will be 90% of 220.

10. <u>Multiple Participation:</u> A bowler will be allowed to bowl unlimited times in the Doubles event, providing a different partner is used. A bowler may only bowl once in the Singles event.



11. <u>Squad Scheduling</u>: All entries shall be scheduled on a first come first served basis for the shift requested in the order of receipt in the hands of the Association Manager or by the post office postmark. The Association Manager reserves the right to cancel a shift if deemed in the best interest of the tournament. However, additional shifts and times may be added to scheduled tournament dates, if necessary, based on number of entries received and lane availability. Once an entry is processed and assigned to a squad, a processing fee of \$10.00 will be changed to reschedule days and times bowled.

12. <u>Line-Up and Check-In:</u> Once entry form has been processed, lanes assigned, and confirmation sent, line-up changes will not be permitted. Substitutes must bowl in the position of the member being replaced. Bowlers must check-in no earlier than one hour and no later than thirty minutes prior to scheduled shift. <u>After tournament play has started, late bowlers will receive a zero for each frame missed.</u>

13. <u>Dress Code:</u> Casual slacks, trousers, jeans and knee length shorts may be worn. The jeans should not have worn, cut or tattered openings in inappropriate areas that show skin or underwear. The Tournament Director will enforce the dress code. She will make judgment calls relative to the dress code questions or concerns and her decision shall be final.

14. <u>Abrasives:</u> In accordance with USBC Rule 18 (Bowling Ball-Altering Surface) the use of abrasives on the surface of bowling balls during tournament play will result in disqualification of the bowler.

15. <u>Lane Courtesy:</u> Only one lane of courtesy will be allowed during tournament play. Only one bowling ball per bowler will be allowed on the ball return rack during the tournament.

16. <u>Injury/Emergency:</u> If an entrant is unable to complete competition due to illness or injury, a substitute will be permitted if available for doubles and the combined score will count. If a substitute is not available, the actual score of the frames bowled shall count. Substitutions made are subject to the approval of the Tournament Director.

17. <u>Ties:</u> In the case of a tie for first place in any event, Co-Champions will be declared based on total pin fall plus handicap. USBC Rule 326a (1) will apply. The cash prizes for the positions affected are to be equally divided.

18. Lane Dressing: Lanes will be dressed prior to each squad using the Bourbon Street Oil Pattern.

19. <u>Bowler of the Year Points:</u> Participants in this tournament will be awarded Bowler of the Year Points at one point per event. For example; bowling in two doubles, singles and all-events would earn four (4) points. Bowlers will also receive points for the top five places in each event.

20. <u>Disputes/Protests:</u> Any disputes or protest which may occur and are not covered by the above tournament rules or USBC rules shall be submitted in writing to the Association Manager before the tournament prize payments are made. All disputes regarding scoring must be reported within 24 hours of scores being posted. Any decision of the Tournament Committee shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
